

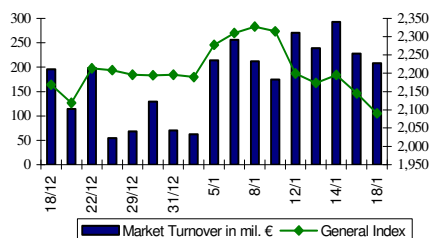

General Index, dipped 3.39% at 2,030.28 on a total turnover of 232.7 mil. euro. Financials dove 5.07%. Piraeus Bank (-6.88%), Alpha Bank (-5.89%), Eurobank (-5.87%), NBG (-5.52%) at 16.26 euro. Ellaktor (-6.22%), and Intralot (-6.15%). HTO was its only composite to end up 0.79%, at 10.17 euro.
